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3.0 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

The bidders must meet the following minimum qualifying criteria:

- 3.1 That, bidder in the same name & style, should be in business at least for three years at the time of bid opening. In case of change of name of the bidder by merger /acquisitions/change in status, the bidder may be eligible based on the documentary evidence.
- 3.2 That, bidder should have valid registration under various act the may be applicable for the supply/contract proposed. This shall include but not limited to Income tax, Companies Act, Goods & Service Tax (GST), Welfare Cess Act apart from any other applicable tax-imposed time to time by State/Central Govt. and Employee State Insurance, Contract Labour, Provident Fund etc.
- 3.3 That, bidder's financial turn-over in the same name & style during each of the last three financial years (2020-21, 2021-22 & 2022-23) should not be less than **Rs. 400 Lakh**.
- 3.4 The bidder should submit copies of Audited Balance Sheet and P&L A/c for the last 3 Financial Years (FY 2020-21, FY 2021-22, FY 2022-23) for income tax purpose. (If not audited, to be certified by CA)
- 3.5 Copy of TDS certificate issued by the client to substantiate the claim for the value of works executed in the private sector
- 3.6 Copy of form 26AS for the last three financial years.

Note: The documents should be enclosed in Cover "I" (Technical Bid) by the Bidder. All the photocopies are to be self-attested.

4.0 BID/ OFFER SUBMISSION:

- 4.1 BIDS to be submitted in single stage two cover system i.e., Pre-Qualification/Technical Bid (Technical Envelope) and Financial Bid (Commercial Envelope) as detailed below:

Envelope 1:

Technical Bid (**Part-1**) : The bidder should submit the relevant documents related to eligibility criteria, technical details for the item/ equipment/ machinery as required in the tender and shall be put under one envelope (Envelope -I) mentioning "TECHNICAL BID FOR CONVERSION OF MILK INTO SMP AND GHEE ON ARC BASIS".

Envelope 2:

Commercial Bid (**Part-2**): The bidders should quote the prices in Indian Rupees in "**Price Bid Format**" enclosed as **Annex-II** and shall be put under one envelope (Envelope-II) mentioning "PRICE BID FOR CONVERSION OF MILK INTO SMP AND GHEE ON ARC BASIS".

Both envelopes (**Envelope-I & II**) to be put under one Main Envelope super scribing clearly-"OFFER FOR CONVERSION OF MILK INTO SMP AND GHEE ON ARC BASIS" and should be submitted at the address mentioned in tender document

Under this process, the Eligibility and qualification of the bidder will be first examined based on the detail submitted under first cover (Technical Bid) with respect to eligibility criteria and specifications prescribed in this tender document. The Price Bid under the second cover shall be opened for only those bidders whose technical Applications are responsive to eligibility and qualifications requirements as per Tender document.



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4.2 Bids can be sent by post/ courier or submitted by hand at our office by time as specified in tender notice. Bids received late shall be rejected. For bids submitted by post or Courier, it is bidder's responsibility that bid reaches our office on or before the scheduled time and date.

4.3 In case tender opening date is declared a Holiday, bids shall be opened on next working day at the same time specified in tender.

4.4 The offers received through other E-mail will not be considered.

4.5 The rates should be quoted in prescribed format only.

5.0 VALIDITY OF BIDS/ OFFERS:

The Bids /Offers shall remain valid **for 120 days** from the date of bid opening prescribed by the JMF. A bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by JMF as non-responsive

6.0 OPENING OF BIDS:

6.1 Technical bids of the bidders whose bids have reached the office of JMF on time as mentioned in the IFB and shall be opened in the presence of bidder on the date and time specified in the tender document.

6.2 Bidders may be present at the time of opening of the bids.

6.3 **Commercial bids will be opened only those bidders whose Technical Bid (Part-I) is found to be acceptable by JMF. Such eligible bidders will be intimated the date of opening of Commercial Bid (Part II) separately.**

7.0 EVALUATION OF BIDS:

7.1.1 Preliminary Evaluation

JMF will examine the technical bids to determine whether they are complete, whether required EMD and supporting documents have been furnished, and whether the bids are generally in order.

Where the bidder has quoted and the bid security furnished is inadequate, the bid will be treated as non-responsive.

JMF will also examine whether the bid is complete. If the prices of certain item are found as "0 (Zero)" it will be presumed the bidders have included the cost of such items against some other items of the price bid. The bidder shall furnish the details of such inclusions separately along with their Technical Bid (Part I).

Prior to the detailed evaluation, JMF will determine the substantial responsiveness to the bidding document. A substantially responsive bid is one, which conforms to all the terms and conditions of the Bidding Document without material deviations. A material deviation is one which affects in any substantial way the functionality, scope, quality or performance of the deliveries or which limits in any substantial way inconsistent with the bidding documents, JMF's rights or the bidder's obligations under the contract and the rectifications of which deviations would affect unfairly the competitive position of other bidders presenting substantially responsive bids. JMF's determination of a bid's responsiveness is to be based on the contents of the bid itself without recourse to extrinsic evidence.



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No post-bid clarification at the initiative of the bidder shall be entertained. For evaluation and comparison of bids, the purchaser may, at its discretion, ask the bidder for clarification on the bid. The shortfall information / documents shall be sought only in case of historical documents which pre-existed at the time of tender opening and which have not undergone change since then.

So far as the submission of the documents is concerned with regard to qualification criteria, after submission of the tender, only related shortfall documents shall be asked for and considered. For example, if the bidder has submitted a supply order without its completion / performance certificate, the certificate can be asked for and considered. However, no new supply order shall be asked for and considered so as to qualify the bidder.

In case the required clarifications are not received by the Purchaser in time, the Technical bid may be treated as incomplete and non-responsive.

A bid determined as not substantially responsive will be rejected by JMF and will not subsequently be made responsive by the Bidder by correction of the non-conformity.

JMF may waive any minor informality or non-conformity or irregularity in a bid which does not constitute a material deviation, provided such waiver does not prejudice or affect the relative ranking of the Bidder.

7.1.2 Evaluation and Comparison of Bids:

The Evaluation and comparison of bids shall be done on the basis of event wise quoted price (inclusive of applicable GST) for conversion charges considering the estimated inward and outward transportation cost for supply of raw milk and collection of converted products.

- 8.0 Any attempt by a Bidder to influence the Procuring Entity “The Jharkhand State Cooperative Milk Producers’ Federation Ltd. (JMF)”, in the examination, evaluation, comparison, and post qualification of the Bids or Contract award decisions may result in the rejection of its Bid, in addition to the legal action which may be taken by the Procuring Entity under the Act and the Rules.
- 9.0 Information relating to the examination, evaluation, comparison, and post-qualification of Bids, and recommendation of contract award, shall not be disclosed to Bidders or any other persons not officially concerned with such process until information on Contract award is communicated to all Bidders.
- 10.0 To assist in the examination, evaluation, comparison and qualification of the Technical or Financial Bids, the Bid evaluation committee may, at its discretion, ask any Bidder for a clarification regarding its Bid. The committee’s request for clarification and the response of the Bidder shall be in writing.
- 11.0 Any clarification submitted by a Bidder with regard to his Bid that is not in response to a request by the Bid evaluation committee shall not be considered.
- 12.0 The determination of qualification of a Bidder in evaluation of Technical Bids shall be based upon an examination of the documentary evidence of the Bidder’s qualifications submitted by the Bidder and in accordance with the qualification criteria indicated in Qualification and Evaluation Criteria. Factors not included in Qualification and Evaluation Criteria shall not be used in the evaluation of the Bidder’s qualification.
- 13.0 The Bid evaluation committee shall have full powers to undertake negotiations where it deemed necessary. Negotiations may, however, be undertaken only with the lowest Bidder(s) only.



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14.0 Award Criteria

14.1 JMF will award the contract to the successful bidder whose bid has been determined to be substantially responsive and has been determined as the lowest evaluated bid.

14.2 JMF may award one single contract or more than one contract to the successful bidder at JMF's discretion.

15.0 **Signing of Contract:** Within 07 days from the receipt of the Purchase Order, the successful bidder shall return the duplicate copy of the Purchase Order, duly signed and sealed, Performance Security, wherever applicable.

16.0 **Rights Reserved by JMF:** JMF does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid. JMF reserves the right to award the job either in part or full. JMF at its sole discretion and without assigning any reason thereof, also reserves the right to accept any/or reject any or all bids.

Note:

16.1 Deviations in commercial terms and conditions of the bid may be rejected

16.2 The Bidder should mention the HSN/ SAC Code of each item along with the Technical Bid (Part I).

16.3 GST TDS as per section 51 of CGST Act 2017 will be deducted, if applicable.

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18.0 SPECIFIC TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- 18.1 The bidder should have required mechanism with experience Technical Manpower to run Milk Processing, Powder, Ghee Plant etc
- 18.2 The bidder should have sufficient and proper storage facilities for Milk, Powder, and Ghee.
- 18.3 The bidder should have GST No., PAN, FSSAI License, BIS certifications, Factory License and any other License if any.
- 18.4 The bidder must be having equipped Testing Laboratory with latest facility to test milk, Milk Powder, Butter and Ghee.
- 18.5 Milk shall be supplied to conversion plant only if there is any surplus milk available beyond the installed capacity / emergency breakdown at JMF Dairy, Hotwar Plant.
- 18.6 The weight and test shall be redone at BIIDER'S plant for confirmation of quantity and quality of milk received by BIDDER.
- 18.7 Converted SMP shall have to confirm to BIS standards & Ghee shall have to confirm to Agmark special grade standards.
- 18.8 **INSPECTIONS:** All the SMP/Ghee produced is subject to inspection before acceptance. If they are rejected on quality grounds, then the party will have to manufacture SMP/Ghee from own resources and supply equivalent quantity of SMP/Ghee as per standards.
- 18.9 The packaging materials for packing of SMP shall be provided by JMF whereas for packing Ghee, the Ghee Tin 15kg packing shall be provided by bidder.**
- 18.10 It would be mandatory for the bidder / service provider to print the declaration like "**Best Before**" as per the packaging of various acts.
- 18.11 The sample of SMP & Ghee shall be tested by you at bidder's lab in presence of JMF chemist and a COA (Certificate of Analysis) submitted to us certifying the quality of SMP & Ghee, for a final subsequent checking at our laboratory.
- 18.12 Milk & SMP, WMP & Ghee should be tested by same lactometer, i.e. ISI.
- 18.13 For ISI Type Lactometer: Formula to be followed for SNF% calculation at 27°C shall be as below:
- In whole milk $SNF\% = CLR/4 + Fat\% \times 0.25 + 0.44$
 - In skimmed milk $SNF\% = CLR/4 + Fat\% \times 0.25 + 0.44$



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19.0 GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- 19.1 SUB-CONTRACTING OR SUB-LETTING: The bidder is prohibited from sub-contracting or sub-letting of the work to any other agency.
- 19.2 The bidder should provide its detail in the format enclosed as **Annex-I**,
- 19.3 The RATE/OFFER to be quoted in the prescribed format enclosed as **Annex -II- “Financial/Price Bid”**. The mentioned rates shall be firm and remain applicable during the entire period of the Contract.
- 19.4 **Packaging: SMP Bag along with liner shall be provided by JMF. However, Ghee Tin shall be provided by bidder.** The provided Ghee Tin (15 Kg Ghee Tin) should be of below grade/ material:
- 19.4.1 **Material:** Standard grade single cold reduced electrolytic tinplate and inside double food grade non-toxic lacquering including Newman cap seal. The tin coating thickness shall be of grade E 2.W2.8. **Tin Coating** can be checked by **IS 1327 Test Methods**).
- 19.4.2 **Body:** Body shall be manufactured from one piece of tin plate.
- 19.4.3 **Handle:** Shall be of galvanized steel wire conforming to IS 280
- 19.4.4 **Soldering:** Soldered seam shall be covered with a suitable food grade non-toxic lacquer on the inside and outside.
- 19.4.5 **Supplying Condition:** The tins should be free from rust, any foreign material inside / outside and free from lacquering solvent odour.
- 19.4.6 The test certificate of raw materials used for manufacturing of tin shall be require along with every supply.
- 19.5 The rate to be quoted in Indian Rupees Only.
- 19.6 The Offers should be strictly according to our requirement / specification and scope of work, failing which it may not be considered.
- 19.7 Transportation cost of Milk and Finished goods will be borne by JMF.
- 19.8 Insurance also will be borne by JMF.
- 19.9 Loading arrangement of Commodities should be done by the party (Bidder).
- 19.10 The Contract can be terminated by giving one-month notice from either side.
- 19.11 **PAYMENT TERM: - 100% payment shall be made within 30 days after receipt of materials and submission of bills which shall be made only after physical inspection/verification of the products at site and quality acceptance by JMF authorized person. Payment shall be made through NEFT/ RTGS.**
- 19.12 The Bidder must provide copy of GST Certificate, PAN & Bank Details along with the quotation/ tender.
- 19.13 **Consignee/ Billing Address:** Jharkhand State Coop Milk Producers' Federation Ltd), F.T.C. Campus, Sec-II, H.E.C., Dhurwa, Ranchi (Jharkhand)- 834004 (GSTIN: 20AADAT8604K1ZJ).



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19.14 The staff of the JMF /JMF authorized person shall have the right to inspect the bidder / service provider plant / office for checking quality of product manufactured / packed / supplied for JMF, as well as maintenance of plant, temperature of product kept in cold store, weight / quantities of packs, hygienic conditions in the plant or any other matter relating to product.

19.15 On receiving orders from JMF, the supply of Product at Jharkhand Milk Federation, Ranchi shall be the responsibility of the supplier. The rejected material, if any, shall have to be lifted by the supplier at their own cost within a week time from the date of intimation from JMF. JMF shall not be responsible for any deterioration due to delayed lifting of the rejected material by the supplier.

19.16 The Offer/Bid document submitted by a tenderer shall become the property of the Federation and the Federation shall have no obligation to return the same to the tenderer.

19.17 **Dispute/ Arbitration & Final Authority.**

19.17.1 Bid Rejection Criteria:

A Bid may be rejected / treated as non – responsive if:

- The Bidder fails to send /submit the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) amount within the bid due date.
- The Bidder does not meet the Eligibility or Pre-Qualification / Technical criteria and / or non-submission of documents specified.
- The deviations from the terms mentioned in the document affects in any way of scope, quality and performance.
- Conflict of Interest between the Bidder and the JMF is detected at any stage
- Tender/ Bid document is unsigned and incomplete in any aspect.
- Bid validity is shorter than the required period

19.17.2 Disputes:

The Federation (JMF) and the bidder shall make every effort to resolve any dispute / disagreement in connection with the bid amicably by direct negotiation. However, the decision of managing Director, JMF will be final & binding in case the disagreement or dispute if not resolved by mutual negotiation.

Legal dispute if any, concerning to this supply shall be subject to such courts as Exercising Civil Jurisdiction over Ranchi

19.18 The tender document submitted by a tenderer shall become the property of the JMF and JMF shall have no obligation to return the same to the tenderer.
